- ✓ Completed application
- ✓ Personal statement (include activities, goals, community involvement, and reason you should be chosen; double-spaced, no more than 500 words)
- ✓ Essay (Topic: What makes a credit union different from other financial institutions; double-spaced, no more than 500 words)
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation from non-relatives
- ✓ Letter of acceptance to any in-state college, university, or accredited trade school

Please submit the application package by May 1, 2010. We will accept your application package at any branch office, by email at [MemberService@AllegisCU.com](mailto:MemberService@AllegisCU.com) (Subject: “Member Scholarship”), or by mail (Attn: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 177, Oshtemo, MI 49077).

Completed package must be received together. Mailed packages must be postmarked by May 1, 2010 and are good for current academic year only.

On June 1, 2010, one member will be chosen from each branch office to win a scholarship of \$1,000, good for tuition at any in-state college, university, or accredited trade school.

All entries become property of Allegis Credit Union. Essays will not be returned and may be published.
